Sr. Stella Barrientes passed on to eternal life with God on June 21, 2018 after 104 years of life. Those of us who knew Sr. Stella may remember her with dancing heart and feet and smiling eyes as she shared her great love of music and art with her students and with the Sisters. Her many years of teaching included schools in Beeville, Brownsville, Corpus Christi, Port Isabel, and Goliad. Her joy in life served her well in her ministry. She stated that her desire "has always been to teach children about God and to bring the good news of salvation in all areas of my ministry."

In addition to her teaching ministry, Sister Stella taught conducted reading and art workshops, and gave first aid classes for the American Red Cross. Her volunteer work with the Red Cross also included entertaining handicapped children. Through the years she also sponsored the Sodality and the Legion of Mary, coordinated CCD and the Catholic Youth Organization.

She has often exclaimed in wonder," It doesn't feel that I have lived this long!" The Incarnate Word has blessed the congregation with over seventy years of joyful presence and love in his beloved Sister Mary Stella!
